## Police Department

Chief Beal handed out the 2024 Yearly report, even while short staffed the department handled over 2000 calls for service. Monthly reports for January and February where handed out. Chief Beal told the committee that new Officer Grace Millard started on March 20<sup>th</sup> and the new School Resource Officer Jake Borchardt is set to start on March 31. The department currently has one open position.

1850 172 E Oak St. Extension of premise request. Committee discussed that once the street construction is done and the lay out of the new sidewalk is completed that it could then be sent to council for approval.

2025 State Grant Director Zank indicated he has received the grant and is working on what can be purchased with the funds
