The Common Council of the City of Juneau ordains: Section12.20.020 of the Juneau Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as shown.

12.20.020- Powersand Duties of the Sexton. The Sexon shall perform all duties as set forth in this section and prescribed by the Finance Committee and report viloations to the Mayor or City Attorney for prosecution. The Sexton shall be subject to the following general rules and regulations:

- No person shall inter any body without first notifying the Sexton and furnishing the necessary information required to complete the Sexton's records. The records of the Sexton shall consist of the name, age, sex, residence, place of birth and when practicable, disease or manner of death; such report is to be filed with the city clerk.
- Funerals, while within the cemetery grounds, will be under the control of the Sexton, or a member of the city crew, one of whom shall be in attendance at every internment.
- 3. The Sexton or city employee shall supervise the digging of graves and see to it that they are properly dug. The Sexton shall also direct how and where any body not belonging to the owner of the lot shall be buried and prevent the deposit of any body in any unsold lot or in any lot which is the property of another without the owner's consent.

- All internments on lots shall be restricted to family members of the family unless permission in writing from the lot owner is filed with the Sexton.
- 2. The internment of two bodies in a grave (that is one above the other) will not be allowed, except a parent and infant child or infant tin children buried at the same time, but two or more internments of cremated remains may be together with other remains in one grave.
- The Sexton shall have exclusive direction over all internments and disinternments and no person shall perform such labor except under the Sexton's supervision and direction.
- All contracts and agreements in respect to the business and affairs of the cemetery shall be executed by the council.
- Enclosures around lots such as hedges, fencing, ect., will not be permitted.
- The common council may alter an d repair an structure on any lot that becomes unsightly or dangerous, the cost of which shall be paid by the owner.
- All funeral or cut flowers placed on lots or graves shall be removed by the Sexton or other authorized person as soon as they wilt or become unsightly if not removed by the owner.

- If any tree or shrub situated on any lot shall become detrimental to any adjacent lot or street, or unsightly or inconvenient, authorized persons shall remove such tree or shrub. or such parts thereof.
- Shrubbery, flowers. vases, bouquets, or any decoration of any kind, shall be placed on on the grave side of the markers and shall not extend more than eighteen (18) inches upon the grave nor exceed the width of the marker. No glass or other fragile vases will be allowed. The City shall not be liable for any lost or damaged decorations or ornaments.
- The cemetery will have two annual cleanups: April 15 and November 15. Decorations must be removed from the site prior to these dates. All items will be removed and discarded. Decorations may be placed after April 22 and November 22, respectively. Notification of cleanup will be published in area newspapers.
- Urns and other similar structures shall be placed in line with the row of monuments.
- 5. No person shall enter the cemetery between nine (9) p.m. and seven (7) a.m.
